What to bring to my WIC appointment at NACA's Family Health Center

Proof of Identity:

- Photo ID- Work or School
- Driver's License/ State ID
- Tribal Enrollment Card
- Social Security Card
- Hospital/Immunization Record
- AHCCCS Card

Proof of Identity for Child:

- Immunization Record
- Birth Certificate/Social Security Card
- Tribal Card
- Foster Care/ Adoption Papers
- Crib Card, Hospital discharge papers,
- Hospital ID bracelet (Newborns only)

Proof of Residency:

Proof can show the caregiver or applicant's name, domestic partner's name, spouse's name or if under 18, the parent or guardian's name.

- DES or Tribal Social Security Eligibility Letter
- Drivers License/ State ID
- Letter from social services/ housing
- Court Documents
- Rent Lease agreement
- Rent /Lease Receipts
- Utility Bill
- MVD
- Proof of Insurance
- Bank Statement
- Payroll Sub
- Letter from homeowner that person resides within their home.
- Letter of notification addressed to the client

Proof of Income:

Required for ALL people living in the home

- Proof of DES Assistance Program
- Eligibility (SNAP, TANF, AHCCS)
- Recent Paystubs (30 days)
- Per Capita payment stubs
- SSI Award Letter
- Alimony/ Child Support Papers
- Self-Employment Records
- Most recent Year Tax Returns/ W2
- Letter from Employer stating current pay

Additional Items:

- Proof of Expectant Due Date (If applicable)
- Special Formula Authorization Form (If applicable)
- Child(ren) / Infant (If applicable)
